Why Conduct a Lottery?

- A lottery is required by the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction if the total number of applications received exceeds the number of seats available.
- The new student lottery application period was January 3 - March 29.
- Lottery tonight will be broadcast via [Livestream.com](https://www.livestream.com) and will be recorded & archived.

Lotterease

- Lotterease is a software program designed for schools that manages applications, runs the lottery, and maintains the waitlist.
- Parents create an account to submit the application and use that account to track their student's place in the lottery and waitlist, if applicable.



Application Tiers

Three Application Tiers:

- Tier 1 - priority enrollment for children of staff members
- Tier 2 - priority enrollment for siblings of currently enrolled students
- Tier 3 - enrollment for general public

Next Steps for Admitted Students

- Enrollment packets must be picked up by 3:30 pm on Tuesday, April 16.
- Completed enrollment packets must be returned by 3:30 pm on Wednesday, May 1.
- **Kindergarten students and students new to public schools only** will have until the 1st day of school (August 26, 2019) to return the health assessment form to us. All other completed forms in the enrollment packet are due on by 3:30 pm on May 1.
- Birth certificates must be the original birth certificate or a certified copy obtained from the county in which your child was born.

Next Steps for Admitted Students

- We will need to make a copy of your North Carolina Drivers License.....OR....two other forms of proof of NC residency (as defined in your enrollment packet).
- Kindergarten - 5th grade students pick up & return their completed packets to Mrs. Ravan in the enrollment office at the elementary campus located at 110 East 3rd Avenue.
- Middle and high school grades (6-12) pick up & return their completed packets to Mr. Benfield at the secondary campus located at 2970 South New Hope Road.

Waitlisted Students

- If your student is waitlisted and a seat becomes available, you will receive an email from Lotterease.
- The email will contain due dates to confirm or decline the spot, pick up enrollment materials, and return enrollment materials.
- You can track your student's place on the waitlist by logging into your Lotterease account.

Coming Fall 2020 ... We're Expanding!

- New high school will open in Fall 2020 for students in grades 9-12.
- In 2020-21, we will add one class per grade level, K-8.
- **This will open up an additional 25-27 seats for each of those grades.**
